KS1 and KS2 Robin Hood and Medieval Life

Overview of activity	<p>Join the outlaws of Sherwood for an immersive session and hear the tales of The Merry Men and their adventures in Sherwood Forest. Learn about life back in the 13th century and discover the secrets of being an outlaw.</p> <p>There will also be activities where children can learn about historical artefacts, build their own Medieval timeline, take aim and test their archery skills on our soft archery sets and design their own heraldry coat of arms to take home.</p>
Key information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Suitable for (key stage): KS1 and KS2 • Duration: 90 minutes • Available in your own school grounds. This session takes place outdoors on your playground or field area. Adverse weather may affect the session and may result in a re-scheduled date • Max group size is 15 children • Activities are adapted to KS and age of the group
Day itinerary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Welcome to the Medieval tent by the outlaws. (5 Minutes) • Begin your adventure by listening to tales from long ago. (25 Minutes) • Three-way activity rotation: Soft Archery Heraldry Coat of Arms activity Medieval timeline (KS2) and Merry Men Character match game (KS1) (15 minutes per activity) • Artefacts and question time. (15 Minutes)
Key learning outcomes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Understand how we used to live • Learn about different jobs in the medieval forest • Improve understanding of the legend of Robin Hood • Learn about medieval artefacts • Learn about Local History and historical people
